NACHA Requirements for ACH Transactions

The National Automated Clearing House Association (NACHA) adopted specific rules regarding International ACH Transactions (IAT). NACHA requires entities originating ACH (Direct Deposit) payments to comply with IAT rules and federal law. All payees are required to identify the intended final destination of payments issued through the ACH network. (For further information on these rules, please contact the UT Payroll Office).
